NOTICE OF RACE

1. A 2.4mR Open Meeting will be held at Llangorse Lake, Brecon LD3 7TR on Saturday 6th & Sunday 7th April 2019. The organising authority will be Llangorse Sailing Club.
2. Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.
3. Competitors will be honorary members of Llangorse Sailing Club for the duration of the event and by entering, agree to be governed by the Club Rules.
4. The Open Meeting is restricted to 2.4mR. Racing is scheduled as follows:

Number of Races 5
1 Race will constitute a series.
When 4 or more races have been completed a boat's score shall be her race scores excluding her worst score.
5. Briefing 12:15hrs

Start times Saturday:
Race 1 will not start before 1300hrs. Races 1,2 & 3 will all be back to back
Start times Sunday;
Race 4 Not before 10:30 hrs races 4 & 5 will be back to back
6. Competitors may enter by completing an official entry form and paying the fee of £20.00. The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/competitor or crew as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races. That the safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat.
7. Measurements:

All boat shall comply with the Class Design rules (available from the ISAF website www.sailing.org). Competitors' attention is drawn to A12 – "Validity", Section B – "Certification", and Section C – "Conditions for Racing", of the Class Rules

8. The Course:

The course to be sailed will be windward/leeward, including a windward spacer mark and a leeward gate.

The target race duration will be 50 minutes

9. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

1st 2nd & 3rd for the overall Open Meeting and the Collier Cup in Memory of David Collier for the first Llangorse boat
